PRIVATE PARTIES

The Board of Directors approved the rental of the Clubhouse, **UNDER THE FOLLOWING RULES** as we follow the **STATE'S COVID PROCEDURES**.

WE WILL BE FOLLOWING STATE GUIDELINES. IF A PARTY DATE IS BOOKED, IT MAY BE CANCELLED DUE TO A STATE MANDATE. (deposits will be returned)

- No more than 50 people are allowed at the party.
- ALL Residents and Guests must wear a mask while indoors, regardless of vaccine status.
- Residents/guests must wear a mask while entering/exiting building and in the common areas of the Clubhouse. Once in the rented room, mask wearing and social distancing will be the sole responsibility of the Resident hosting the affair.
- Staff will have limited contact with guests. If an issue arises, the Resident and attendant will resolve the problem. Signage will be posted.
- Party Room Rates on Friday through Sunday afternoons and evenings: \$300 with a limit of **50 people**.
- If the Library is rented with the Party Room, the Library is only \$150.00.

REMINDERS

- All trash cans must be stored in the garage and items such as ladders, construction and lawn materials, cannot be visible from the street.
- Signs - "Other signs (beyond For Sale/Rent and time restricted political election signs), including signs for commercial purpose, are not allowed at anytime"
- Seasonal decorations must be removed no later than January 31st.
- If you have a dog, make sure you pick up after it; also make sure it is not disturbing your neighbors and that it is on a leash when outside.
