THE OUTDOOR POOL OPENS SATURDAY, MAY 28th

Very exciting, the Outdoor Pool will be opening this year on Saturday, May 28th. Chicagoland Pool Company will be Bloomfield Club's pool company. They will provide lifeguards for us. (please see attached flyer regarding lifeguard hiring) The lifeguards/attendants will be taking IDs, filing them and issuing ID bracelets. ID bracelets will be in place this year. Adult ID Cards are the ONLY card that opens the front door or east/west gates.

Please follow Clubhouse procedures:

<u>14-17 year-olds</u> may use the outdoor pool without an adult with a lifeguard present. 14-17 year olds are asked to ring the doorbell and have their card available to show the attendant. **Children under 13** MUST be with an adult.

<u>Guest procedures</u>: Each household is entitled to two Guest Cards, which are coded to their household. Each household may borrow six Guest Cards from other Residents and/or the Clubhouse. Therefore, a resident could bring as many as eight guests.




