The BCRA Board has revised the Clubhouse User Agreement, and the revised agreement will be posted on the website, you can pick up a copy at the Clubhouse, or if requested, it can be e-mailed to you. Highlights include: Event hours have changed to align with our new clubhouse hours. Events are limited to five (5) hours per event. All adult homeowners hosting the event must present their Club ID's to be copied at the signing of the agreement so we know who is hosting the event. Adult homeowners **MUST** be present for the set-up, the entire event, the cleanup and the pre/post inspections. Maintenance has the final signoff on all inspections, usually occurring the next day. The rental fees have remained the same.

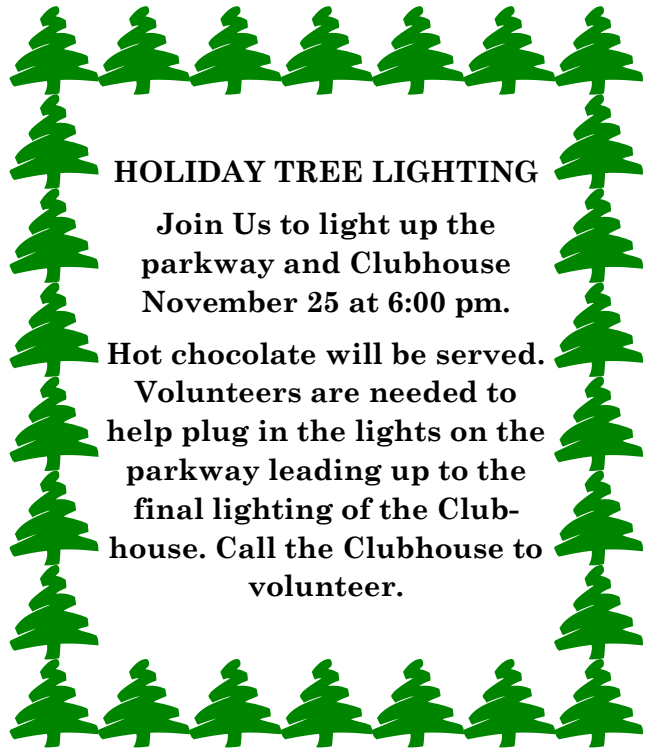
TOY DRIVE

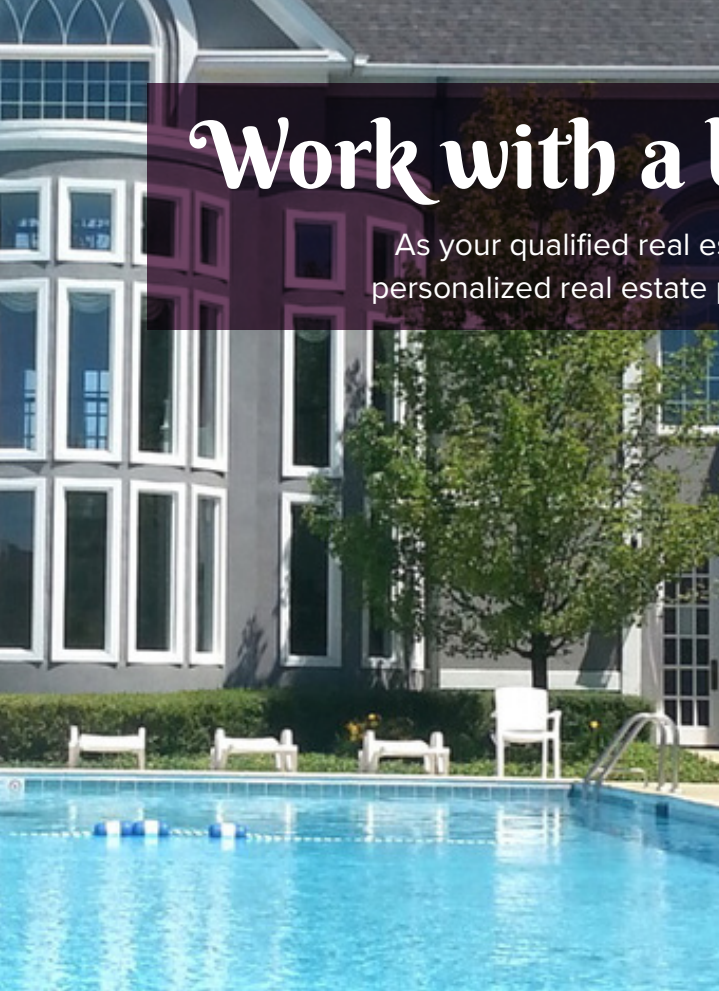
